Spotlight Series 4 returns to an in-person live ticketed event that will bring together music, multimedia, and the visual arts to a live audience. This series featured artists include local Port Hope musician and award-winning author of over 40 books <u>Ted Staunton</u> and <u>David Shewchuk</u>, current concertmaster of The Quinte Symphony and touring violinist, fiddler, and composer.
